1	Is it acceptable to apply the Training and Technical Assistance funds to augment the Targeted Initiatives Grant?	No, The Training and Technical Assistance funds cannot be used to augment the Targeted Initiative grant.
2	Would an allowable activity be training our target audience and Board of Directors on ROMA?	No, the intent of this NOFA is to be used to provide training to all CSBG eligible entities on Community Engagement, Consumer Input and Involvement, or Community Economic Development.
3	Given the short turnaround for this grant, we may not be able to get the full curriculum from our proposed trainer. Would an outline be OK?	Yes, an outline can be submitted with the information as noted on page seven of the NOFA, Section 4: Training and Technical Assistance Curriculum, the applicant shall describe the T&TA curriculum and resources and provide the following details: 4.A - Describe the curriculum and information that will be provided, 4.B - Explain what resources and final “products” that will be provided to T&TA participants.
