



LOW-INCOME WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM FOR MULTIFAMILY PROPERTIES

PROGRAM SUMMARY

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

California's Low-Income Weatherization Program, administered by the California Dept. of Community Services and Development, installs rooftop solar systems, solar hot water heating systems and energy efficiency measures for low-income households to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and save energy.

Launched in early 2016, the Low-Income Weatherization Program for Multifamily Properties (LIWP-Multifamily) is already proving to have a significant impact. Properties participating in LIWP-Multifamily have reduced energy usage by an average of 44%.

LIWP-Multifamily is on track to meet its greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction goals in part because its one-stop-shop program approach makes it easy for property owners to access high-impact incentives for energy efficiency and renewables and because of the high demand for these energy saving strategies.

The \$38 million previously allocated is currently fully subscribed, and the program has more than 180 additional affordable rental properties on the program waitlist. LIWP-Multifamily will continue to benefit a diverse range of building sizes/types, property owners, low-income renters, and regions as long as funding continues to be made available.

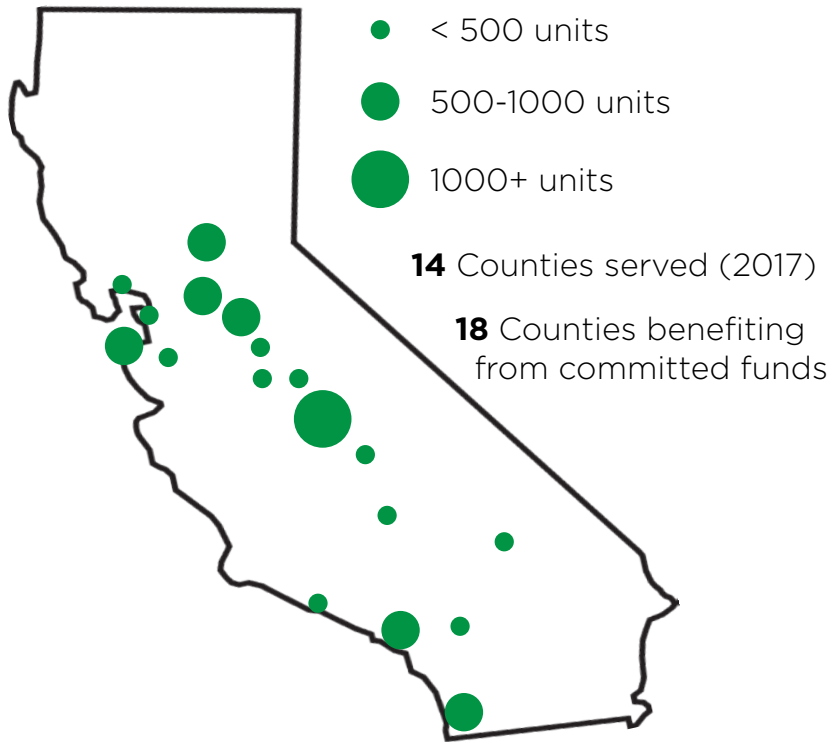

- Provides owners with a single point of contact for comprehensive technical assistance.

- Integrates whole-building energy efficiency, solar thermal, and solar PV under a single program.
- Aligns well with other existing incentive programs to leverage additional funds and expand the retrofit scope.
- Uses a portfolio approach to identify eligible properties.
