**Service Category Definitions**  
**Emergency Heating and Cooling:** Financial assistance to repair and replace non-functioning household heating and cooling systems.  
**Wood, Propane and Oil:** Financial assistance for the purchase of wood, propane, and oil for home heating.  
**Severe Weather Energy Assistance and Transportation Services:** Assistance to address energy related emergency needs. Can include utility assistance, temporary housing, transportation, and portable heating and cooling.  
**Public Safety Power Shut-Off Preparedness:** Services for medically vulnerable households in designated High-Fire Risk Areas. Includes risk assessments, supplies, and battery backups.  
**Utility Assistance:** Financial assistance to reduce energy bills and prevent disconnection.
