



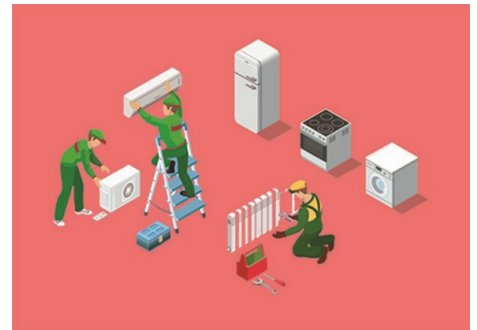
Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program

The federally funded Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (**LIHEAP**) provides assistance to eligible low-income households to manage and meet their immediate home heating and/or cooling needs. This includes financial assistance to offset heating and cooling costs for low-income households, assistance to low-income households in a crisis situation such as utility disconnection or a life-threatening energy-related crisis, and weatherization services that help to reduce heating/cooling costs and improve household energy efficiency, while improving the health and safety of occupants.

Low-income households spend a large share of their income on home energy costs:

- U.S. Families Spend 8% of Income on Home Energy
- Low-Income Families Spend 17.2% of Income on Home Energy
- LIHEAP Recipients Spend 17.3% of Income on Home Energy

The **LIHEAP Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)** provides financial assistance to offset heating and/or cooling costs for low-income households.

The **LIHEAP Energy Crisis Intervention Program (ECIP)** provides assistance to low-income households in a crisis situation, such as receiving a utility shut-off notice or other energy-related emergency created by a natural disaster. **ECIP Heating and Cooling Services (HCS)** provides for the emergency repair or replacement of a home heating and/or cooling system.

The **LIHEAP Weatherization Program** provides services to improve the energy efficiency of a home to reduce energy usage and costs, while improving the health and safety of occupants. Weatherization measures include weather-stripping, insulation, caulking, water heater blankets, heating/cooling system repairs, energy-efficient lighting, thermostat repair/replacement and other measures.

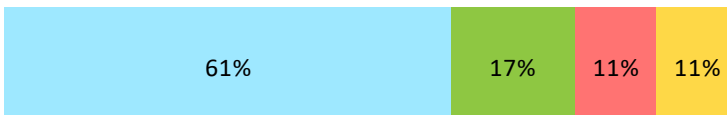
